State officers Meeting has been moved to August 7th due to Deb Butitta's Celebration of Life on August 6th. 51 new members. Treasurer gave excellent comprehensive report on TBFS which made a significant profit. If you want to be on the 2023 TBFS Committee, reach out to Jim Buttsback. Thank Scarlett Fever for stepping up & playing an additional night with extremely short notice! State voted yesterday on State Held Funds and a motion passed to start each Chapter at zero due to the lack of financial records from a significant time period. Mormon Lake is no longer a viable venue for TBFS due to numerous issues including: cleanliness and solidness of cabins and rules that affect our vendors and attendees (no beer & legal vendor was not approved of by venue owners) – long term plan is to attain own property & are looking into what grants are available for ABATE's use to this end. Question came up if changing our Designated Lobbyist from Mike I to his company Epic Policy Group would create any conflicts of interest with other



parties/clients the company represents. High Country Chapter has potential Treasurer they are talking with and they are continuing the Toy Drive and Chili Cook off as well as having a 'Meet Your Officers' event. Yavapi Chapter's viability is being monitored as the recent loss of Deb B left two positions vacant. Upcoming events to keep in mind: Meeting of the Minds and MRF's induction into the Sturgis Hall of Fame in Deadwood.
